Spotlight – Write On and Fresh Voices

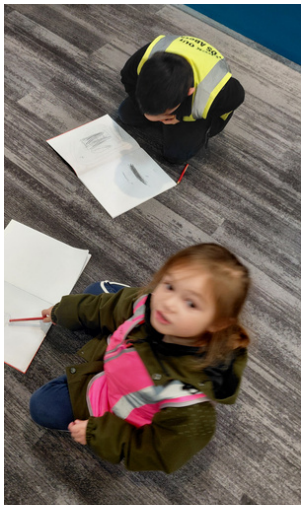
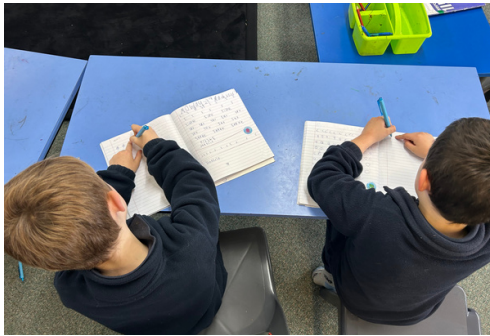
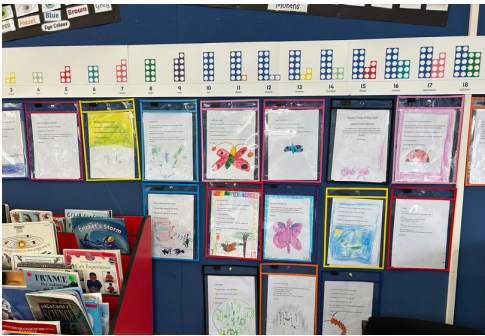
